

# THE SLUM SULMA SANSULA SET UP NAI WAI #1

Since 2006 a refugee from Sri Lanka has lived in this shack in a converted **pig farm**. At the time his ISS-HK case worker was Ms. Sulma Samsula, currently manager of ISS Prince Edward branch.

Ms. Samsula put this individual in a position whereby he had no choice but to accept an illegal hut as his home. Having been destitute for seven years, he still lives in the hut he maintains and improves with no assistance from indifferent ISS and landlord.

Ms. Samsula's actions make it clear it has been ISS-HK policy and practice to not pay rental deposits and put claimants in slums from as early as 2006. This is an outrageous longterm and continuing breach of the SWD housing specifications and what we can only assume would be a breach of the SWD - ISS contract.
