
THE SLUM ACROSS THE PATH CHUNG UK TSUEN #1

Due to unaffordable rent, many ISS clients have moved out of this slum. The landlord knows that helpers (FDH) pay rent and utilities on time to secure a quiet weekend get-away.

Here 12 refugees live in remodeled pig and chicken shacks on two sides of one footpath. Oddly ISS contracts show the same address 200m across the path in a different location.

This sprawling shanty has a long history. It is said that nighttime fighting discouraged some refugees from staying. Not surprising when living in such destitution with no jobs.











