These are photos of several shacks around the village of Ping Che. Refugees are settled in diverse structures ranging from warehouses to old rusty shacks without water or plumbing.

Conditions differ widely depending on slum lords' interest in their tenants: some even offer free electricity, while others extort exorbitant rates with unprecedented greed and rapacity.

Refugees are stuck into any hole that meets the description of “having a door, four walls and a roof”. Kitchens, toilets, showers and other basic amenities are not required by ISS.

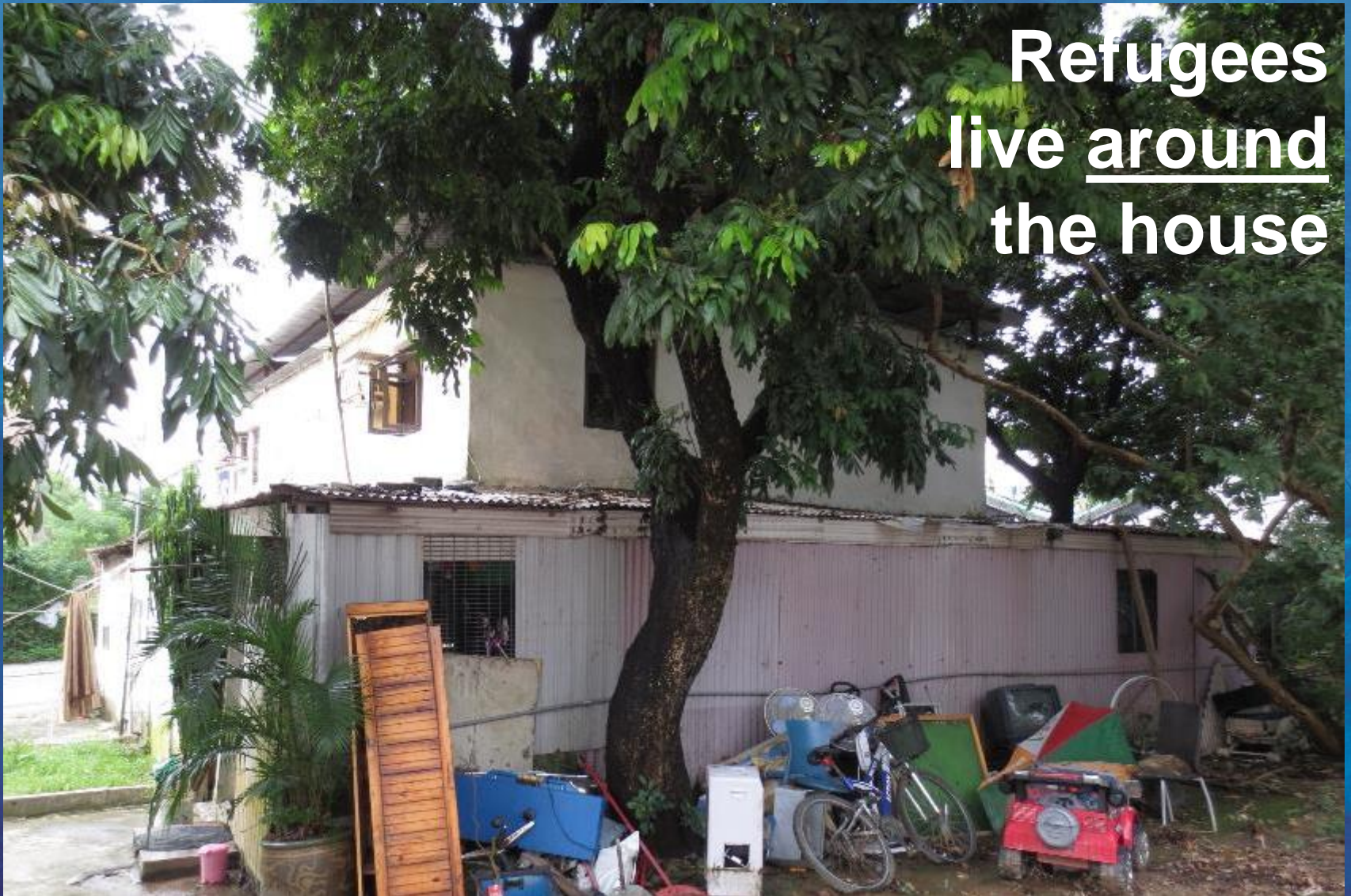

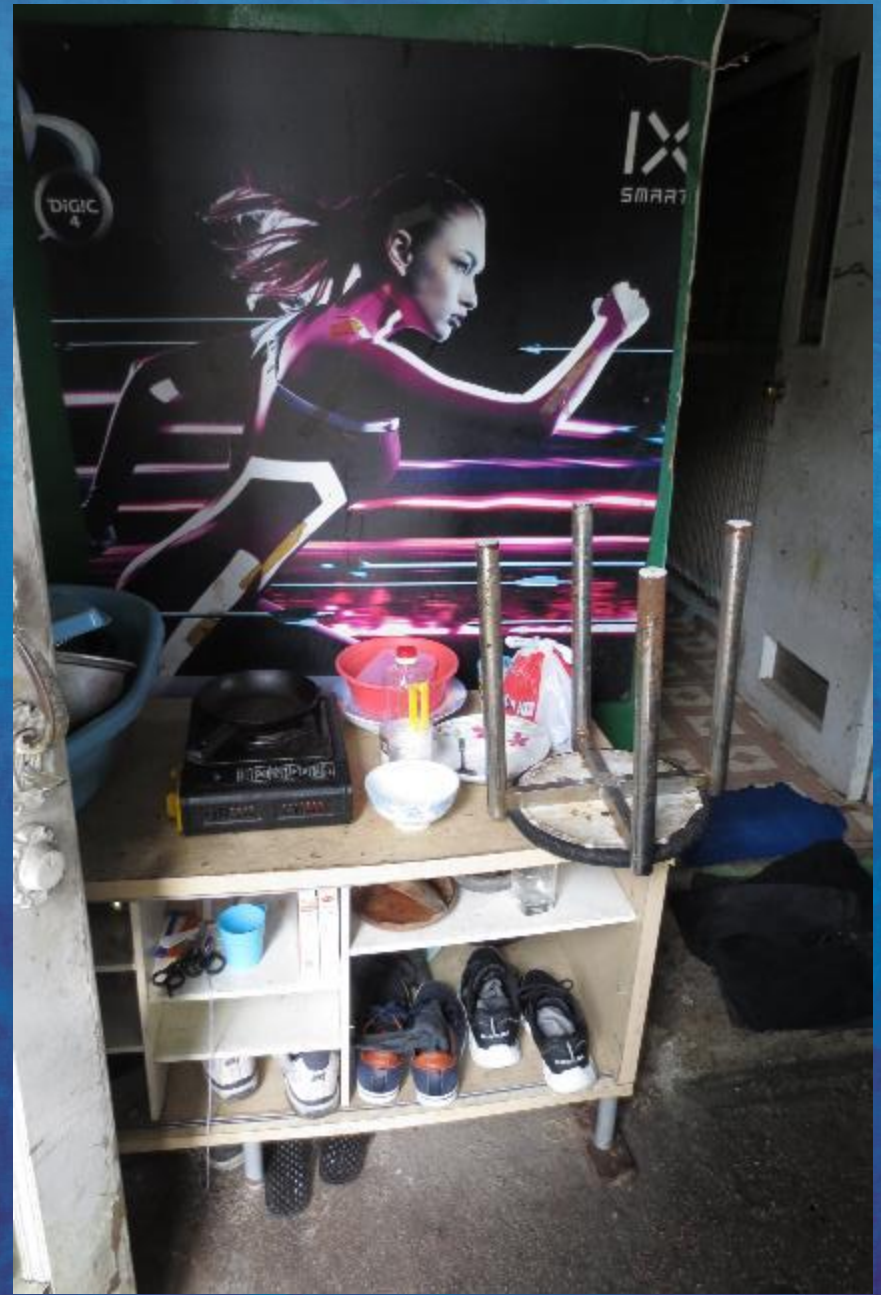
