


# THE SLUM IN THE PIG FARM

## HUNG SHUI KIU #2

Since 2009 ISS-HK settled refugees in these derelict pig farms around Tin Sum Tsuen. This location is near the poultry farm featured in South China morning Post and Apple Daily.

The refugee tenants are clueless about their rights. They know nobody except ISS-HK that is perceive as “being Hong Kong Government” since all assistance comes from their offices.

Conditions are primitive. Refugees cook on wood fires when they cannot afford to buy gas. Yet it appears slum lords are developing more rooms despite notices from the Lands Dept.

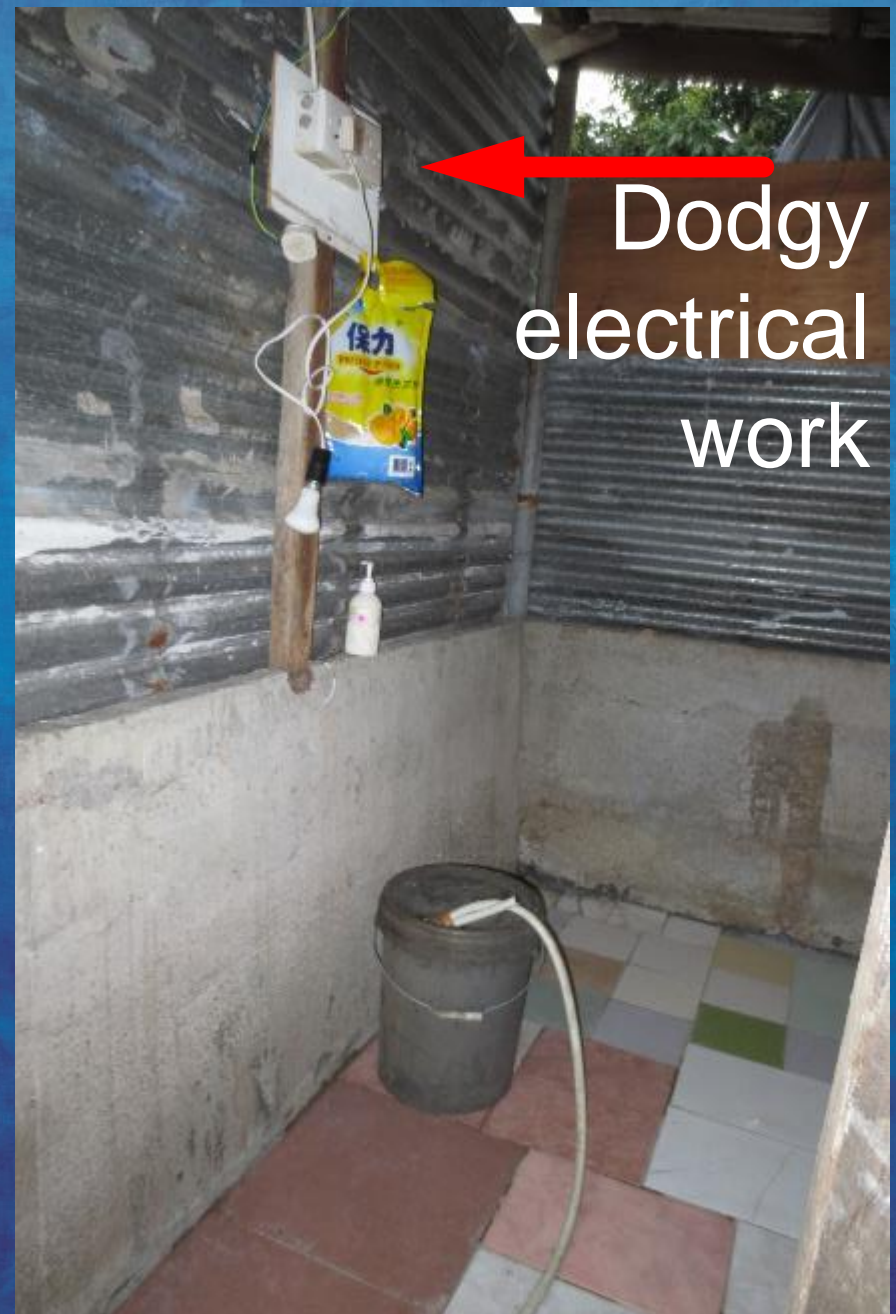
