
THE SLUM IN THE POSH CHICKEN FARM YUEN LONG #7

It's clean, organized and has a granite yard, but also this location is illegally. It takes experience to notice it was formally a chicken and pig farm. From the rooftop the agricultural use is unmistakable.

The landlord reconstructed a long chicken shed into a guesthouse. A posh metal gate opens onto a tiled yard. There are 15 small rooms with wooden doors, but only 1 cooking area and 1 toilet.

This compound is relatively tidy. The investment pays a good return with 12 ISS clients from India, Pakistan, Indonesia and two African refugees who could not afford anything better or closer to town.
