After years of cooperation, in 2012 ISS-HK dropped this refugee ghetto. The landlord said he could not supply the right documents they wanted, though previously it was fine.

While ownership of the land is not in question, the change of land use appears to have been the issue. Yet, compared to other slums exposed by Vision First, it is one of the very best.

Serious concerns remain about the legitimacy of documents held on file by ISS-HK when these better rooms are banned, while elsewhere filthy and dangerous ones are approved.
