A rusty gate leads to a site where refugees live among impoverished residents at the bottom of the economic ladder. Yet refugees are banned from minimum wage work (32\$).

Here residents live in better homes inside proper structures, while the rusty metal huts are reserved for refugees.

There is disparity even at the very bottom of the social order.

We found pain and suffering in the lives of these refugees; mothers who cannot provide enough for their children, adults who despair of ever emerging from crushing social isolation.












